IUOE Unit 12 Representatives Meet with Parks and Recreation on Reorganization Plan – September 14, 2018

Last Friday, IUOE Unit 12 representatives met with the Department of Parks and Recreation to discuss their reorganization plan.

As part of their Operational Transition Plan the department has developed new district boundaries, going from 18 park districts and 4 Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Districts to 22 integrated districts.

The reason given for the restructuring is to decentralize the operations, beef up staffing, and to have a Program Manager at each District.

As a result of this reorganization, the department plans on hiring as many as 83 new employees of which a majority will be Unit 12 classifications.

With the redrawing of the District boundaries, the Department has assured us that none of our Unit 12 members will be transferred or relocated. They will continue to report to the same areas, just the supervision will be changing.

The 83 new positions will be funded by SB 1 monies.
